Proposal: Erection of Single Storey Rear Extension

Applicant: Mr A Wardell

Cllr Howard explained that he had done a site visit. The planned build takes in the original footprint of the existing conservatory with additional infill across the back of the property. The proposed construction in brick is in keeping with the main building. The extension is unlikely to have an adverse impact on neighbouring properties. Following discussion, the Parish Council agreed it would improve and enhance the existing dwelling and resolved to fully support the application.
