LITTER PICK

We are in the process of arranging a village litter pick for the morning of Saturday 21st March. Details will be confirmed when they are available. It would be nice to see as many of you as possible come out to help keep the area litter free.

FIRST AID

Both the Village Hall Committee and the Parish Council are considering investing in First Aid training and facilities for the community. Many rural communities have seen the benefit of having some basic training and some are investing in defibrillators. If you have an interest in attending a first aid course or in other such services please contact the Clerk.

WAYBROOK LANE

We are still waiting for news of the impact of the South West Exeter development on Chudleigh Road and

Waybrook Lane. This is a major concern for the parish council and we have already made representation to the District Council planners that we do not want traffic from the new developments turning roads in the villages into 'rat-runs' and we are working closely with our Teignbridge District Councillors to get the best outcome for the parish.

HIGHWAYS

With the cold and wet weather comes issues with our roads, drains and gullies. The County Council are only fixing issues that have been reported; there is no ongoing maintenance. As detailed in our recent minutes we have logged several items, but potholes and blocked drains should be reported.
