Following the recent election we have two vacancies on the Parish Council. If you are interested in becoming a Parish Councillor please get in touch with the Clerk. We meet six to ten times a year depending on the number of planning applications that we receive and it is a chance to get involved in and to understand local issues. We work with local agencies and the District Councillors to address items such as highways, planning, grant applications and housing.

ANNUAL MEETINGS

Thank you to those that came to our recent annual meetings and made a comment. We've been busy working on the points raised and hope to have answers to them all shortly.

CORRESPONDENCE

We are speaking to SWW regarding the water leak on

Manstree Road earlier in the year and hope to have some answers to their handling of the matter very soon. We have received confirmation that the petition about the 366 bus was received by Devon County Council. We are all waiting to see what happens following the consultation. The Parish Council are also talking with the Planning department at Teignbridge Council about how local knowledge can be better incorporated into their decision making process. Finally we are working with Highways to get the outstanding issues resolved and are starting a potential two year process to get the main road through Shillingford resurfaced.
