Shillingford Parish Council are delighted to announce that as part of their commitment to make Shillingford Abbot and Shillingford St George safe and healthy places to live, we have been successful in our bid to the National Lottery for funding to purchase two defibrillators. One will be located outside Shillingford St George Village Hall and the other will be in the telephone kiosk in Shillingford Abbot. We will keep you updated with progress of this project.

Free awareness sessions will be available to enable you to familiarise yourself with the equipment. The chances of surviving a cardiac arrest will be significantly greater with access to this vital equipment.

We have also just heard that we have been successful in our application to the British Heart Foundation for a free training resource to enable us to regularly offer defibrillation training/familiarisation without incurring additional costs of engaging a trainer.

In April twelve of our parishioners took advantage of the free first aid training course which we ran in conjunction with St Johns Ambulance. A further course is planned for June. If you are interested in securing a place on the course please contact the Parish Clerk
