DEFIBRILLATORS

A familiarisation session has been arranged with the Community Heartbeat Trust who supplied our defibrillators. The session will be in the village hall in Shillingford St George at 10am on Saturday December. It will take about an hour and will introduce the defibrillation equipment and how to use it. Whilst you don't need to be trained to use the defibrillator, as it gives verbal instructions, being with familiar the equipment and processes will help you remain confident in a crisis. please come along and find out how you could save a life.

VILLAGE HALL TOILETS

The Parish Council have been successful in an application to Teignbridge District Council Elector fund and have an additional £342 to donate to the toilet refurbishment fund

WAR MEMORIAL

The war memorial at Peamore has been given listed building status due to the historic interest of its origin. The war memorial at Shillingford St George was deteriorating due to lack of air and light and therefore the tree canopy above it has been raised.
