

WOULD YOU BE PREPARED TO HELP SAVE A LIFE?

We have had our defibrillators in the parish for 2 years now. If you were the only person with someone suffering a cardiac arrest, how would you get to the defibrillator at the same time as giving life-saving first aid? There is a service that would phone 10 local volunteers on a cascade system to find someone in the village who would fetch the defibrillator and bring it to you. There is a cost to setting this up but the Parish Council would ask for grant funding if we have enough people interested in helping. If you would be prepared to be part of this vital team, please contact our Parish Clerk.

VILLAGE GREEN TRUST

The Village Hall committee have confirmed that they have done their best to achieve a compromise with the Trustees over the use of the village green for the benefit of the community. Both the Parish Council and the Village Hall committee have repeatedly appealed to the good nature of the Trustees, offered mediation and sought an acceptable outcome to restore open access to the car park and village green. The Parish Council maintains its position. The Trustees are not fit for purpose, are breaching Trust Law, the Trust Document and should resign.
