Minutes of the meeting held by Zoom on Tuesday 11th July 2023 at 5pm (17:00 hours)

- 01/23/23. Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Lake.
- 02/07/23. Declarations of interest of items on the agenda - none
- 03/07/23. Approval of the amendment to the standing orders for zoom meetings – a resolution was approved by all councillors for the amendment to the standing orders
- 04/07/23. Planning:-
23/00640/HOU Loft conversion with rear dormers and roof lights to the front | Meadowend. A discussion was held on the positioning and the council are in support of this application.

23/01149/HOU Four free-standing solar arrays, Grange House. The council supports this application.
- 05/07/23. Neighbourhood Plan – Cllr Parrot is planning to seek support from the parishioners to see how much interest there is within the council area as the first step. Teignbridge may be able to provide some support towards this. Cllr Wareham raised the aspect of a specific skill set, what is required.
- 06/07/23. Speedwatch. Cllr Wareham provided an update as more data is required and this has to be considered a long term project that requires a large amount of manpower. Options were discussed and the discussion moved to the 20 is plenty campaign. Cllr Barwell provided an update on the 20 is plenty and how the CIL funding maybe able to assist with this. Cllr Parrot reminded the council about Whitstones implementation of a speed warning sign as mentioned at the last meeting. A motion will need to be past to start the scheme. Cllr Barwell provided details of the other requirements to be considered and for the council to consider joining another local council. The matter will be put on the agenda in September.
- 07/07/23. Important Financial matters – Approval of the DALC invoice was raised, other financial matters will be dealt with this next week in relation to the AGAR and bank mandates.
- 08/07/23. Parking on St. Georges Terrace, Cllr Lake has been involved, with both the police and Teignbridge housing. Exminster Parish Council are keen to reinstate TALC, Cllr Parrot would support a version of this. Cllr Lake in his report raised issues on the local plan.
