LITTER PICK

The annual litter pick has been arranged for 10am on Saturday 11 March, starting at Shillingford st George village hall. This is supported by Teignbridge. All equipment will be supplied. Please come along and help us tidy up our villages before the hedgerows and verges begin to grow.

PURCHASE OF A PROJECTOR AND SCREEN

Due to Teignbridge District Council moving to a paperless planning process the parish council have considered options for projecting plans at meetings. A ceiling mounted projector was considered so that it could be utilised for wider community use such as film nights. Sadly, the cost was prohibitive. Therefore, a portable projector and screen will be purchased to facilitate the planning requirement at meetings.

DEFIBRILLATOR CABINET CODE.

The Parish Council has decided to purchase key fobs which will have the code for the village defibrillator cabinets. We will be giving one to every household. There will be a few spares so if anyone would like a second key fob, please contact the parish clerk and they will be issued on a first come basis.

APPLICATION FOR FUNDING TO PURCHASE A SALT DISPENSER

The Highways dept. has launched a Highways Community Enhancement fund for parishes to bid for funding to carry out activities no longer done by the authorities or other agencies. An application has been submitted on behalf of the Parish Council who wish to purchase a salt dispenser to enable the parish snow warden to grit the parish roads so that residents can get to more passable roads safely.

DONATION TO VILLAGE HALL TOILET REFURBISHMENT FUND

The Parish Council were successful in their bid to Teignbridge Elector fund for £342 towards the village hall toilet refurbishment fund. This has been passed to the village hall committee along with a donation of £1000 from the Parish Council to assist with the fund raising. The refurbishment will not only benefit the community but should assist in making it a desirable venue for events and enabling future village hall upgrades.
