We are really fortunate that a parishioner has offered his time and skills free of charge and DCC have given us a grant of £550 towards materials. FIRST AID & DEFIB AWARENESS

The Parish Council hosted a free First Aid and Defibrillator awareness session on Saturday 16th February. It was a really practical input delivered by a local paramedic and our thanks go to him for giving up his time for such a worthwhile cause. 13 people attended and learnt vital lifesaving and skills as well as emergency first aid. We used the CPR training kit that was donated to the Parish Council by the British Heart Foundation. This kit comes with a useful DVD to guide you through how to administer CPR. If anyone was unable to attend the session and would like to book out the equipment to learn at home, please contact the Parish Clerk.

WAR MEMORIAL RESTORATION

An application has been made to the War Memorials Trust to restore the memorials at Peamore and the junction with Manstree Road in

Shillingford St George. Due to the Centenary, there have been an exceptional amount of applications. We hope to hear if we are through the first application stage by the end of March.

RESURFACING NEAR THE OVER BRIDGE IN SHILLINGFORD ABBOT

The Parish Council raised the poor standard of road surface with Highways Department last August. The contractors had accepted liability for the poor standard of the resurfacing work and had agreed to undertake remedial work. This has not yet taken place and the Parish Council have requested an update.
